- Conducting women oriented programs.
- Organizing class-wise cultural activities to enable all students to participate in some activity or the other.

1. ACTIVITIES REFLECTING THE GOALS & OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTION:

All the activities conducted in the College during this academic year are in tune with the goals and objectives of the institution. The institution was established with the primary goal of providing an opportunity of higher education to all, especially to the rural youth. It is note-worthy that a majority of students in our College are from rural areas and most of them belong to economically and socially weaker sections of society.

The primary aim of our institution is to effect a harmonious development of the physical, intellectual, moral and emotional life of students to enable them to face the challenges of life in a progressively competitive society. Another goal of the institution is to provide value-based education by helping the youth to develop a sense of duty, service, responsibility, honesty, discipline and self-respect.

During this academic year several activities and programmes were organized by the college, which adhere to the goals and objectives of the institution. They are aimed at overall development of the personality of students.

2. NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES INITIATED (UG AND PG):

The College started Open and Distance Learning Program of Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi, during 2008-09. 43 students have enrolled for various PG, UG and Certificate courses for June 2011 session and January 2012 session. This scheme specially helps the rural students to pursue higher education through distance learning method without affecting the quality of education. Orientation Programme for I year IGNOU students was held during November 2011.

3. INNOVATIONS IN CURRICULAR DESIGN AND TRANSACTION:

The college is affiliated to Mangalore University. As such the College does not have freedom in framing the curriculum. However, the College offers a wide range of program options that provide adequate academic flexibility. Some of the faculty members of the college have been members of various bodies of the university like Board of Studies, Faculty of Arts which play a major role in designing the curriculum.

Credit Based Semester system has been in vogue for a few years in the college. Under the scheme students improve their skills by participating in National Service Scheme/ Sports and Games/ Rovers and Rangers or cultural activities. Marks are awarded to them based on their performance in their respective field of activity.

4. INTER-DISCIPLINARY PROGRAMMES STARTED:

Under Credit Based Semester system introduced by Mangalore University during 2005-06 all the students of First year degree have to study Constitution, Human Rights, Environment and the second year BBM and BA students have to study Computer Application.

Since examinations are conducted as per the University guidelines, the College does not have much freedom to introduce examination reforms. However, the performance of the students is continuously monitored. Internal tests and examinations are held in every semester.
